General Rules

Entries

1. Competition is open to the world. Entries will be submitted to the Permian Basin Fair Office by August 17, 2019. Entry forms can be found on the Permian Basin Fair website (www.permianbasinfair.com). Make check or money order payable to: Permian Basin Fair & Exposition

2. One exhibitor per form. No limit on entries.
3. Entries must be postmarked by August 17, 2019 and received within seven (7) days of deadline.
4. Entry form and fees are due at the time of entry.
5. Late entries will be accepted until a postmarked date of August 24, 2019. Late entries will require an additional \$20/head plus entry fee.
6. Entry fees are \$30/head. Exhibitors are required to complete Form W-9.
7. Extra stalls for tack or extra space may be purchased for \$30/stall.
8. The breed registry, registered name of the animal and registration certificate number for each entry is required at the time of entry. The name and registration number of the sire and dam is also optional to be listed on the entry form, and must also be received by the Permian Basin Fair office by entry deadline. Additionally, the original registration paper and a copy of the registration certificate must be presented at check in.
9. We do not mail entry receipts.
10. Adult or youth may enter Open Cattle Show.
11. All cattle must be registered as the property of the exhibitor in the records of a recognized breed association as of the ownership deadline of August 1, 2019.
12. All animals must be tattooed or branded, and an animal's identification must correspond to its official registration certificate
13. Only those cattle entered in the show may be brought onto the fairgrounds.
14. The Permian Basin Fair Livestock Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry not submitted in a timely manner.
15. The act of entering an animal is the giving of consent by the owner, exhibitor, fitter, trainer, or responsible person to have disciplinary action taken by the Permian Basin Fair Livestock Show for violation of show rules, policies, and procedures without recourse against the Permian Basin Fair. Disciplinary action may include dismissal from the grounds, disqualification, withholding of premiums or awards, fines, prohibition from future participation and/or reporting violations to government agencies or other fairs and livestock shows.
16. Substitute entries are allowed within each breed on or before August 24th. Substitute entries outside the entered breed will be required to pay a \$30 fee. Substitute paperwork must be mailed to Permian Basin Fair attention Livestock Committee **and** you must contact a member of the Livestock Committee. Substitutions must include a copy of the substitute animal's registration papers and the complete
