Permian Basin Rabbit Show Rules

- 1. This show will be governed by the latest ARBA rules. Permian Basin Fair and Ector County Coliseum has the right to refuse entries and will not be responsible in case of fire, theft or accidents.**
- 2. No changes or substitutions can be made after Friday, September 6, 2019 9:00pm. Make all entries/changes at the secretary's table prior to the deadline.**
- 3. The decisions of the judges will be final. Exhibitors attempting to or actually interfering with, annoying or trying to influence a judge, or behaving in an unbecoming manner will be rejected and barred from the show, forfeiting all entry fees.**
- 4. All stock must have a permanent legible tattoo in the left ear.**
- 5. Only show officials and judges are allowed in the judging area.**
- 6. The show officials will determine the selection of judges and the order of judging . No special judging will be considered.**
- 7. Owners are responsible for getting their own rabbits to the show table.**
- 8. Any exhibitor wishing to file a written formal protest must make a \$100 payment to Permian Basin Fair and given to the Show Superintendent. Then will be heard by the show committee.**
- 9. Showmanship is only open to 4-H or FFA members. There will be a Junior & Senior showman buckle awarded.**
