Permian Basin Rabbit Show Rules

- 1. Classes will be broken by weight.**
- 2. Rabbits are not to be over 10 weeks of age. Minimum weight of 3 1/2 pounds. Maximum weight 5 1/2 pounds.**
- 3. The decisions of the judges will be final. Exhibitors attempting to or actually interfering with, annoying or trying to influence a judge, or behaving in an unbecoming manner will be rejected and barred from the show, forfeiting all entry fees.**
- 4. Breeding date is May 31, 2019 for the 2019 show. All stock must have a permanent legible tattoo in the left ear.**
- 5. Only show officials and judges are allowed in the judging area.**
- 6. Only youth between the ages of 9 years old, but not older than 18 years old and must be a 4-H OR FFA member.**

- 7. Owners are responsible for getting their own rabbits to the show table.**

- 8. Any exhibitor wishing to file a written formal protest must make a \$100 payment to Permian Basin Fair and given to the Show Superintendent. Then will be heard by the show committee.**

- 9. Showmanship is only open to 4-H or FFA members. There will be a Junior & Senior showman buckle awarded.**

- 10. Exhibitor's must bring water and feed containers and are responsible for the care of their own rabbits. Each animal must be exhibited in its natural condition. An exhibitor in violation of this rule will have their animal disqualified, and the remainder of their entries may be disqualified from the competition and not be judged.**

- 11. Permian Basin Fair will not be responsible for any loss or damage.**

- 12. The Fire Department requires that we maintain aisles in case of an emergency.**
