Livestock Events – Open Junior Market Goat Rules 2019

- Livestock Events General Rules & Regulations apply to these shows.
- There will be two shows, Show A & Show B.
 - Exhibitors wishing to participate in Show B must be registered in Show A.
 - Show B will start after Show A is completed.
 - Exhibitors with multiple entries in one class refer to the General Rules and Regulations.
- Market Goats must be on the grounds by 7:00 pm.
 - **NO LATE ARRIVALS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- Exhibitors will weigh and turn in weights and ear tag numbers of their own market goat.
 - Market Goats will not be allowed in the show ring without ear tags, existing ear tags may be used or ear tags can be purchased for \$5.00 in the Livestock Events Office.
 - Weights should be turned in as soon as possible.
 - 7:00 pm is the deadline for all weights.
- Wether and doe kids may be shown.
- No paint, powder or artificial coloring is allowed.
- Market Goats must be slick shorn to a uniform length.
 - 3/8 inch of hair or less above the hock and knee joint at time of show
 - Exception, tail hair is allowed.
- There is be a 30 lbs. minimum weight and no maximum weight limit.
 - There will be a 3 lbs. weigh back on the top of the class.
 - Any market goat weighing 3 lbs. over the top of the class will be disqualified.
- Exhibitors will be allowed to use halters or collars in the show ring.
- Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their animals in assigned pens.
 - Some market goats may need to be tied.
- Horns should be tipped before arrival on show grounds.
- This is an open sanctioned junior market goat show.
